

NSC Season Talking Points

The following information is provided for families that are considering joining, or continuing on with, the NSC community.

NSC Mission Statement

NSC is committed to providing youth soccer players ages U9 to U19 with an environment of continual player development in a competitive atmosphere to help all qualified players reach their full potential. NSC empowers its Coaches and Teams to embody full sportsmanship both on and off the pitch and embrace opportunities to give back to the community that we live in.

Initial Registration Information

Season Start Date: June – Coaches will determine at what point in June your team will start their season and will kick the season off with a team meeting.

NSC Fees

- \$820– NSC Registration Fee (covers field rentals, League fee, Home match referee crew, NYSA Administration, NSC Club Discretionary, NSC Director of Coaching (DOC) and NSC Keeper Coach)
- \$170 – Uniform Kit, Ordered on even years. Approximate cost.
- \$200 – Team Fee, Approximate, TBD by and paid to the team Treasurer (covers tournament entry fees and Misc. Team expenses)

Please note: Scholarships are available through a confidential application process with the NYSA office.

Summer Pre-Season

- Field training 2 days a week, 1.5 hours each
- Goalkeeper training 1 day per week, by age group for active goal keepers on the team
- Tournaments: Teams should plan to participate in a minimum of 2 sanctioned tournaments
- Camps and Clinics: At this point these are TBD and will be announced by the NSC Director of Coaching

North Puget Sound League (NPSL) Season

- Field training 2 days a week, 1.5 hours each
- NPSL Fall Games (10 games for U9 and U10, 12 games for U11+) begin in September and end at the beginning or middle of December
- NPSL Fall Games High School (HS) Girl's "Winter" Season runs mid-November through March and games run from December through March

Cranberry Cup Tournament

- NYSA/NSC Hosted Washington Youth Soccer sanctioned tournament over Thanksgiving Weekend (Recommend at least 1 team from each gender/age group participate, tournament registration fee paid by team)

Post Season

NSC Teams have the option to participate in WA Youth Soccer (WYS) State Cup tournaments and NPSL Spring League.

State Cup Tournaments

- Trainings 2 days a week, 1.5 hours each

- Starts after the conclusion of the regular season. Can span into February or Spring depending on the tournament.

- Optional Team Entry

NPSL Spring League (Optional)

- • NPSL hosted Spring Season (6 games)
- • Club Participation Fee: Team to cover home fields and referee crew.
- • NPSL League Registration
- • Training 1 day a week
- • Participation: To be approved by NSC DOC
